NEW POLICY

Proposed New Required Policy 3421 Title IX and Sex Discrimination (Notes from Erie 1):

New required sample policy 3421, Title IX and Sex Discrimination, was developed in response to the United States' Department of Education (US DOE) amending regulations implementing Title IX of the Education Amendments Act of 1972 (Title IX). The amended regulations became effective August 14, 2020. Given the complex nature of these regulations and non-discrimination and anti-harassment laws in general, districts are strongly encouraged to consult with district counsel when reviewing and revising this new sample policy in order to ensure that it reflects their specific circumstances, practices, and needs.

REVISIONS

Proposed Revisions to Policy 5670 Records Management (Notes from Erie 1):

Policy 5670, Records Management, has been revised in light of the New York State <u>Archives</u> revising and consolidating its local government records retention and disposition schedules and issuing a single, comprehensive retention schedule for all types of local governments. The new schedule, <u>Retention and Disposition Schedule for New York Local</u> <u>Government Records (LGS-1)</u>, supersedes and replaces <u>Records Retention and Disposition</u> <u>Schedule ED-1</u>.

Districts are required to formally adopt LGS-1 by January 1, 2021 when Records Retention and Disposition Schedule ED-1 expires. Upon adoption, LGS-1 supersedes Records Retention and Disposition Schedule ED-1. It is <u>not necessary to send a copy of</u> <u>the passed resolution</u> to the New York State Archives. However, districts should keep a record of the date of adoption and maintain the resolution permanently. The New York State Archives has provided a <u>model resolution</u>.

District is in compliance. District to adopt this policy first and then adopt LGS-1 by January 1, 2021. Will be on agenda.
