**Three New Policies proposed from Erie 1:**

**Extraordinary Circumstances (#3520)**

Policy defines circumstances that the District may interrupt operation. The District is not required to close and may choose to continue operation in some form. This also covers what is familiar i.e. snow day. Note specific wording of widespread illness. Send to BOE.

**Remote Working (#6570)**

Discusses in what circumstances a district may allow or require employees to work remotely. It also includes a discussion of general expectations for employees that work remotely. Superintendent's regulation to be created to set forth implementation process. This is done after policy is created and approved. **Send to BOE.**

**Remote Learning (#7150)**

Discusses in what circumstances a district may allow or require students to use remote learning. It also includes a discussion about formats and methods of remote learning and what factors will be taken into consideration when making determinations about how to best deliver remote learning. Although these policies were developed in response to questions raised by the current COVID-19 pandemic, they cover topics that may be applicable and utilized by districts outside of the current situation. Superintendent's regulation to be created to set forth implementation process. This is done after policy is created and approved. **Send to BOE.**
