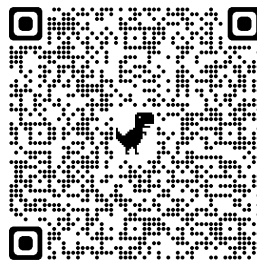

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Session 1- July 10th through July 14th, 2023 (Each session \$75/student)

<p>MUSIC: 9:00am-11:30am <i>Elementary/Middle School Band Camp</i> For band students entering grades 5-8</p> <p>Come play in our summer band camp! We will start new music Monday and will have a concert together by Friday, with a lot of fun along the way! Come join us for a week full of themed excitement (each day will have its own theme!), fun activities, music making, instrument techniques, and meeting new people! Parents/families will be invited to join us for a culminating concert on Friday, July 14th!</p> <p>Taught by Mrs. Cannan (SRE/LE) & Mrs. Carello (CHE/MRE)</p>	<p>ART: 9:00am-11:30am <i>Intro to Photography</i> For students entering grades 5-8</p> <p>Students will use digital cameras to create a variety of photographs using the principals and elements of art. At the end of the session, we will have an art reception for students to showcase their photography.</p> <p>Taught by Ms. Sheldon (LMS)</p>
<p>MUSIC: 9:00am-11:30am <i>Music Explorers' Camp</i> For students entering grades 2-4</p> <p>Have a blast with Music Explorers' Camp for one week. We will engage in singing, play drums, explore the ukulele, and play fun and challenging music games! This is a very social and fun experience for our students with plenty of activities to keep everyone busy all week!</p> <p>Taught by Mr. Taube (CHM/MRM)</p>	
<p>ART: 12:30pm-3:00pm <i>Photography & Emotion</i> For students entering grades 9-12</p> <p>Students will learn the art of creating photographs that depict scenarios and elicit emotions through the use of props and photo editing. They will work independently and in small groups to create powerful images. On the last day, students will curate their work in a showcase of their photography</p> <p>Taught by Ms. Sheldon (LMS)</p>	<p>MUSIC: 12:30pm-3:00pm <i>Rock Band Camp</i> For students entering grades 5-8</p> <p>ROCK ON! This hands-on camp will provide students with opportunities to play guitar, keyboard, bass, ukulele, and/or drumset. Our musicians will be able to work individually and in groups to hone their rock and pop music skills. Students are encouraged to bring their own music if they have it, and additional music will be provided.</p> <p>Taught by Mr. Taube (CHM/MRM)</p>

Session 2- July 17th through July 21st, 2023 (Each session \$75/student)

<p>MUSIC: 9:00am-11:30am <i>Elementary/Middle School Orchestra Camp</i> For orchestra students entering grades 5-9</p> <p>Meet with other Liverpool orchestra students in a group setting to learn more about your instrument, the way music is written, and the language of music in a fun and creative atmosphere of games, crafts, composition, performing and much more! This year's theme will be SUMMER FUN! We will have fun summer themed songs, crafts and activities for you! There will be a short concert to share what we learned on Friday, July 21st at the end of the day.</p> <p>Taught by Ms. Rittle (MRE/MRM) and Ms. Martin (LE/LMS)</p>	<p>THEATRE: 9:00am-11:30am <i>Theatre Explorers' Camp</i> For students entering grades 2-4</p> <p>Enjoy a week of theatre games, improvisation play, and short scenes! Students will engage in a variety of theatrical play, individual improv, group improv, and partner work. There are plenty of exciting and engaging theatrical activities to enjoy all week!</p> <p>Taught by Mr. Taube (CHM/MRM)</p>
<p>ART/THEATRE TECH: 9:00am-11:30am <i>Glow-up (The Art of Theatrical Makeup)</i> For students entering grades 9-12</p> <p>Students will learn and practice advanced theatrical makeup techniques for the stage. Students will learn how makeup enhances the storytelling of a stage production, create vision boards for their characters, and apply their ideas in real time.</p> <p>Taught by Ms. Sheldon (LMS)</p>	
<p>MUSIC: 12:30pm-3:00pm <i>Percussion Ensemble Camp!</i> For percussionists entering grades 5-12</p> <p>The Percussion Ensemble Camp is designed to continue development of snare drum and mallet percussion skills, while also exploring techniques for accessory percussion instruments. Participants will work in small groups to prepare and present an "informance" of small group percussion ensemble music, demonstrating the skills learned throughout the week of the camp.</p> <p>Taught by Mr. Schirripa (LHS)</p>	<p>ART/THEATRE TECH: 12:30pm-3:00pm <i>Intro to Theatrical Makeup</i> For students entering grades 5-8</p> <p>This class is an introduction to theatrical makeup. Students will learn the history of makeup for the stage, create vision boards, and learn makeup techniques that work for the theatrical productions.</p> <p>Taught by Ms. Sheldon (LMS)</p>
<p>THEATRE: 12:30pm-3:00pm <i>Theatre Camp</i> For students entering grades 5-7</p> <p>Let's do some acting! Students will engage in a variety of theatre games, improvisation activities, and scripted scene-work. Throughout the week there will be opportunities to work on solo acting, duet acting and small group scenes. Additionally, students will try their skills at on-camera acting by creating a trailer combining their acting skills with technology!</p> <p>Taught by Mr. Taube (CHM/MRM)</p>	

Session 3- July 24th through July 28th, 2023 (Each session \$75/student)

<p>ART: 9:00am-11:30am <i>The Art of Henna</i> For students entering grades 7-12</p> <p>Have you ever wondered how those beautiful Henna designs are created? We will explore the history of Henna and create our own designs using a variety of inks and stencils.</p> <p>Taught by Ms. Sheldon (LMS)</p>	<p>MUSIC: 9:00am-11:30am <i>Music Explorers Camp</i> For students entering grades 2-4</p> <p>Have a blast with Music Explorers' Camp for one week. We will engage in singing, play drums, explore the ukulele, and play fun and challenging music games! This workshop is designed for students who wish to accelerate their singing, acting, and dancing skills in a musical theatre intensive setting. The camp will culminate in a cabaret-style performance on Friday, July 28th in the LHS Auditorium!</p> <p><i>*Please note the extended hours for this camp.</i></p> <p>Taught by Mr. Taube (CHM/MRM) and Mr. Shatraw (LCSD)</p>	<p>MUSIC: 12:30pm-3:00pm <i>Drum Set Camp</i> For students entering grades 7-12</p> <p>The Drumset Camp is crafted with all levels of performer in mind. Performers will experience the instrument literally from the ground up, both in setting up the instrument and their technique for maximum success. Through the week, we will experience drumming in different styles of music and develop strategies for learning and performing new music so that players can start learning songs on their own.</p> <p>Taught by Mr. Schirripa (LHS)</p>

For students entering grades 6-8

Learn how to create your own short film in a week long film camp! Begin by brainstorming ideas and thinking about narrative structure and the hero's journey. Then, create a shot list and storyboard to plan your film. Once students are ready, they will use Communication Arts CTE equipment to film their own movie while also learning how to set up lighting and sound. In addition to filming, students will market their movies with a poster and some basic photoshop techniques. Finally, films will be assembled with Adobe Premiere and students who feel they are ready can learn some basic editing transitions and effects as well. In the end, students will come away with their own short film to share with friends and family!
